

Integrated Bachelor's/Master's Teacher Education Program

TWO DEGREES + TEACHER CERTIFICATION

The Integrated Bachelor's/Master's (IB/M) program at UConn's Neag School is a five-year program offered to undergraduates at UConn Storrs.

Students apply in the spring of their sophomore year for enrollment starting the fall of their junior year. The program leads to a Bachelor of Science degree and a Master of Arts degree in Curriculum and Instruction or Educational Psychology (special education students), along with institutional recommendation for teacher certification.

Certification Areas Offered:

- Comprehensive Special Education (Grades PK-12)
- Elementary Education (Grades PK-6)
- Secondary Education (Grades 4-12)
 - English
 - Math
 - History/Social Studies
 - World Languages
 - Science
- Music Education (Grades PK-12)

Application Requirements:

- Apply by Jan. 20 of sophomore year
 - Transfer students must apply separately to UConn by Jan. 15 and to the Neag School by Jan. 20.
 - Students studying abroad during the spring semester of their sophomore year must apply earlier, by Dec. 1.
- Earn a competitive GPA
 - Those with a GPA below 2.7 must apply for a GPA waiver.
- Submit an essay describing experiences that have influenced your desire to pursue a teaching career.
- Participate in a successful group interview with faculty.
- Take the Praxis Core exam or meet waiver eligibility by Aug. 1, before the start of junior year.
